We formally apologize for the brevity of this communication, but we feel that it should not detract from our deepest sincerity in dealing with our common interests. China has always been friendly with the people of Africa, from the voyages of Zheng He we have had a benevolent and beneficial relationship. As a significant power in the region, we feel that we have much to discuss.

We understand that while you currently do not hold the dominant position in Darfur, you are a key party to this matter. If we enter discussions as to your oil resources, not only will it mean economic prosperity for our two peoples, but it would lend your cause considerable political clout as well.

Please retain the matter of this discourse in the utmost secrecy.
