The Norway Solution to the Threat Posed by Electronic Waste

1. Deplores the decadent overuse, misuse, and abuse of electronics in the United States of America
2. Calls for the immediate placement of all hazardous electronic waste, within the world, to be placed into reclamation facilities within the United States of America.
3. Authorizes the UNEP to use electronic waste removal techniques to initiate the complete removal of the threat posed by electronic waste,
4. Reminds the committee that the United States of America is the third largest country of electronic waste in the world,
5. Expresses the hope that this action will set an example to prevent the further abuse of the world's ecology.
